

Under AAA Plus Membership coverage, members are entitled <u>up to</u> \$500 in Trip Continuation Protection. The vehicle must be certified disabled for more than 24 hours due to *collision* or *fire* 100 miles or more from the member's home. Members will be reimbursed for expenses for as long as three (3) days for food, lodging and/or alternate transportation. <u>A police report and</u> itemized receipts must be attached to this application.

Trip Continuation Guidelines

- Member is entitled to up to \$500 in Trip Continuation Protection.
- Student member is entitled to up to \$200 in Trip Continuation Protection.
- The vehicle must be certified disabled for more than 24 hours due to *collision* or *fire* 100 miles or more from the member's home.
- Member will be reimbursed for expenses for delay up to three (3) days for food, lodging and/or alternate transportation.
- A police report and itemized receipts must be attached to application.
- If police report shows a ticket was issued, he/she will not be eligible for Trip Continuation.
- Trip Continuation does not cover fuel expenses.
- Member is eligible for one Trip Continuation reimbursement per membership year.
- Must be a Plus Member.
- AAA South Jersey pays out the reimbursements, with approval from VP, Sales & Marketing, and CFO.
